

## **Willamette Leadership Academy 1st & 2nd Battalion Reopening Plans**

Hello, WLA Families,

We hope that you have enjoyed your summer break, and that you are looking forward to our return to school, even though it will look significantly different than it has in traditional years. Know that WLA Staff have been working throughout the summer to adjust and respond to the current guidance and updates from ODE and the State of Oregon, and that the safety of our cadets and staff are a top priority for us.

Due to current metrics and guidance, WLA will start the school year with Comprehensive Distance Learning, and our first day is Wednesday, September 9th. We will use our first day to offer several orientations and introductions to the tools and technology for families. When Lane County Public Health and the state metrics for reopening are met, WLA will move into our Hybrid Learning Plan. Our Hybrid Learning Plan consists of bringing cadets back on campus slowly, with each grade coming in one day a week. After a few weeks of that, we will move to bring cadets on campus two days a week, and so on. All our families will have the option to remain in 100% Distance Learning when we begin our Hybrid Learning Plan. WLA will work hard to keep families updated on the reopening progress.

We are including a broad overview of our Comprehensive Distance Learning schedule so that families can begin to plan their own personal schedules for the school year. We will be sending out information about technology distribution dates (please let us know if you need to borrow a school Chromebook or a Mobile Hotspot here: <https://forms.gle/e8eAYuGHqo7ojW7w6>) as well as information on materials pick up for cadets.

### **Overview of Comprehensive Distance Learning Schedule for 1st and 2nd Battalions**

Below are broad overview schedules for WLA's Comprehensive Distance Learning plan for both 1st and 2nd Battalions. We are not releasing individual schedules at this time, but we do want to provide families as much information as possible so that you may begin to plan.

#### **Helpful Information:**

- *All live Zoom classes will be recorded* and uploaded to Google Classroom. This will ensure that cadets that cannot attend the live classes can still participate in the experience, and this will also allow cadets to revisit content that is delivered in this fashion.
- *Teacher Assigned Learning* refers to learning opportunities that are directed or developed by an instructor, either as a "live" learning opportunity or an asynchronous, or "not live" learning opportunity. This will look like instructors directing cadets to view pre recorded videos with assigned tasks, assigned work and content with instruction included, additional support sessions with a staff member or small group, etc.
- *Applied Learning* refers to additional learning activities for cadets to deepen their engagement and understanding of a topic or activity. This also includes access to staff Office Hours and other independent work.

**Online Registration/Enrollment Access and Directions**

This year WLA is using an online enrollment system to enroll and register all of our cadets. Please use this link to enroll your cadet(s): <https://wlademy.esvportal.com/Login.aspx> This program is mobile friendly, if you need to use a cell phone to complete the enrollment process.

Included in this packet are directions on how to create a parent account and how to register a student. If you are a returning family, you will create your parent account, and then go through the “Returning Student” process. You will need your cadet’s Student ID number, which can be found in ParentVue, on their Student ID card, or many cadets know it as their “lunch number”. New Families will go through the new student enrollment process.
