## Meals at School

Cadets may either bring breakfast and/or lunch or purchase meals in the cafeteria, which are supplied by Springfield Public Schools.

### Meals from Home

If a cadet chooses to bring lunch he/she must follow the guidelines described in Willamette Leadership Academy Standing Orders:

“NO food or drink will be consumed by cadets except during lunch and/or nutritional breaks in the areas as designated by staff.

*‘Snack food’ –including, but not limited to, candy, chewing gum of any kind, cookies, pastries, sodas, energy, and sports drinks which are high in caffeine and/or sugar or sugar-substitute, and/or marketed as “diet” are not considered nutritional or essential to operations. **Drinks and food as described are prohibited.** Such items found on the person of a cadet in any location while on duty are subject to impoundment (see command policy letter dated 10 OCT 07, Searches and Property). Unit commanders may request an exception to this policy for the purpose of a singular event in writing 48 hours in advance of a scheduled event to the Battalion Commander.”*

### Cafeteria Meals

Meals purchased in the cafeteria are supplied by Springfield Public Schools.

Payments for school meals may be paid by cash or check. Make checks payable to *Springfield Public Schools*.
